



New Project LEARNFOOD - has received Nordplus Horizontal grant

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Project LEARNFOOD has received a grant of 42.000 euro for a three-year project from the Nordplus Horizontal Program.

The purpose is to exchange knowledge on how to integrate educational methods with healthy food in schools. Insights from research and practice form the basis of activities, conducted from a horizontal, cross-sector and UNSDG perspective. The partners will co-create educational, innovative methods in participatory ways that involve pupils and teacher-students. The LEARNFOOD project will develop a variety of pedagogical concepts and methods, including ICT based educational materials for information, webinars, collaboration and dissemination.

The project takes a social-constructivist point of departure and partners aim to collaborate as a professional learning community. The results of the project will inform policy both a school and national level. This will promote mutual understanding and future collaboration across countries and sectors.
